## Rules and Regulations for any Recipient of CCCs President or Alumni Scholarship

- 1. A student who received a Scholarship from Carolina Christian College is agreeing to the following requirements itemized below.
- 2. Eligibility for Requirements
  - This policy applies to every student of CCC who receives a Scholarship from CCC.
  - Academic:
    - o The student must maintain a "C" average
    - o The student must attend classes regularly.
    - o The student must provide all of the registration materials required by the College.
    - o The scholarship/grant may be withdrawn if the student does not adhere to the requirements.
    - o If a student receives an "F" grade in a class, he/she must pay the regular tuition charge when the class is repeated.
    - o One semester of probation may be granted by the Academic Dean.
    - o The student must work with his/her faculty advisor and meet with him on a regular basis.

#### • Campus Life:

\*The student must comply with all rules and regulations governing student conduct and activities as stated in the CCC Student Handbook.

#### • Christian Service:

- o The student must be involved in the College's Christian Service program.
- o The student must attend Worship Services at a local congregation each week.
- The student is expected to maintain a commitment to Christian Service and, upon graduation, must continue in some area of Christian Service.
- o In the case of foreign students, they are expected to return to their native country for Christian Service at the completion of their education.

### • United States Government Regulation:

- o The student is to obey all the laws of the United States.
- o Foreign students will not be permitted to work off the college campus.
- o Revocation of Scholarship:

- o Should the student fail to obey the guidelines of this agreement, the Scholarship/Grant will be revoked. When the Scholarship is revoked, the student will be responsible for repaying all the previous assistance granted to the student.
- o A repayment schedule would be established by the College, should it be necessary.

Note: Any recipient of a CCC scholarship will only receive a reduction in his/her tuition. There are no cash refunds awarded to scholarship recipients.
