



Refund Policy

Tuition refunds occur in only a few situations. In these cases, the College will facilitate the refund according to the following policy:

1. **Withdrawal from the Accelerated Program:** If a student must withdraw from the Program, the student must pay for any course already started at the time of withdrawal, including the costs of the texts and materials that have been distributed to the student. If the tuition is paid in full for the semester, the student will be reimbursed at \$950 per course ASAP (\$1665 per course AMP) (no refund for certificate courses) that the student does not take.
2. **Determining Refunds:** For financial aid purposes the Business Office will consider students officially withdrawn as of the last day of the student's attendance.
3. **Federal and State Refund Requirements:** Both the Federal and State governments issue regulations which govern minimum refunds in certain situations. These regulations prevail over the policies of the College unless the College policy results in a larger refund to the student. In this case, the College will give the larger refund.

All credit resulting from Title IV aid is refunded to the students on Tuesday two weeks following the start of class.
