



Transfer of Credit Policies and Articulation Agreements

Carolina Christian College seeks to honor the students' work and credits earned from previous institutions. As such, we will work with students who wish to transfer credits from another accepted institution. We do have guidelines regarding acceptance of transfer credits. Below is a list of the guidelines to which we adhere regarding transfer of credits.

1. For our Bachelor program, no more than 74 semester hours may be transferred. No more than 30 semester hours may be transferred for students enrolling in the master level program. No more than 15 semester hours may be transferred for student enrolling in doctorate program.
2. The student is responsible for arranging for an official transcript of credits to be transferred. Such transcripts should be sent to Carolina Christian College by the institution from which the credit is being transferred before you register for courses.

3. Evaluation of credits from all other institutions is based upon standard views by the American Association of Registrars and Admission Officers.
4. We accept credits from schools accredited by CHEA, The United States Department of Education, or a comparable foreign accrediting body.
5. We accept credits from unaccredited schools on a case-by-case basis.
